RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO A STATE-FUNDED AUTOMOBILE INSURANCE PROGRAM.

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission, to consist of three
2 members of the Senate and five members of the House of
3 Representatives is hereby established for the purpose of making
4 an investigation and study relative to the feasibility of a state-
5 funded automobile insurance program. Said commission shall
6 take into consideration the various administrative, financial and
7 procedural aspects involved. Said commission may require by
8 summons the attendance and testimony of witnesses and the
9 production of books and papers and shall have the authority to
10 travel within and without the Commonwealth. Said commission
11 shall report to the General Court the results of its investigation
12 and study, and its recommendations, if any, together with any
13 drafts of legislation necessary to carry its recommendations into
14 effect, by filing the same with the clerk of the House of
15 Representatives on or before the third Wednesday of December,
16 nineteen hundred and seventy-five.
