AN ACT PROHIBITING BUSING STUDENTS OVER CITY AND TOWN BOUNDARIES IN ORDER TO ACHIEVE RACIAL BALANCE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 37D of chapter 71 of the General Laws, as most
- 2 recently amended by section 5 of chapter 636 of the acts of 1974,
- 3 is hereby further amended by adding the following paragraph: —
- 4 No plan designed to change school attendance districts to
- 5 achieve racial balance shall include busing students over the
- 6 boundary line of any city or town in which such student resides.
