## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Five.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE LICENSING OF INSTRUCTORS IN THE OPERATIONS OF SCHOOL BUSES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law  
2 to the contrary, a person may engage in the business of  
3 instructing in the operation of school buses by being an  
4 accredited school bus contractor and licensed school bus  
5 operator for a period of not less than five years. Such person  
6 shall pay an annual license fee of twenty-five dollars.
