AN ACT PENALIZING A DOG OFFICER WHO REFUSES TO PERFORM HIS DUTIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 169 of chapter 140 of the General Laws, as appearing
2 in the Tercentenary Edition, is hereby amended by striking out
3 the first sentence and inserting in place thereof the following
4 sentence:— A city or town dog officer who refuses or wilfully
5 neglects to perform the duties imposed upon him shall be
6 punished by a fine of not more than one hundred dollars which
7 shall be paid into the state treasury.
