AN ACT AUTHORIZING CITIES, TOWNS, COUNTIES AND REGIONAL SCHOOL DISTRICTS TO CONSTRUCT SCHOOLS IN ACCORDANCE WITH UNIFORM PLANS FURNISHED BY THE SCHOOL BUILDING ASSISTANCE PROGRAM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The school building assistance bureau in the department of
2 education is hereby authorized and directed to furnish uniform
3 plans for the construction of public schools to any city, town,
4 county or regional school district. Said bureau shall provide
5 supervisory and topographical engineering assistance at cost to
6 any such city, town, county or regional school district which
7 uses such plans.
