## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Five.

AN ACT EXEMPTING PUBLIC HOUSING AUTHORITIES FROM THE LAW  
RELATIVE TO TENEMENT HOUSES IN TOWNS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as  
follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 145 of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by striking out section 1, as most recently amended by  
3 section 9 of chapter 707 of the acts of 1966, and inserting in  
4 place thereof the following section:—  
5 *Section 1.* The provisions of sections sixty A, sixty B and sixty  
6 C shall apply to all towns. The other provisions of this chapter  
7 shall apply to all towns which accept it or have accepted  
8 corresponding provisions of earlier laws by a vote of the town at  
9 a town meeting; provided, however, that said provisions shall  
10 not apply to tenement houses erected by a public housing  
11 authority.
- 1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
