AN ACT AMENDING THE LAW RELATIVE TO THE OBSERVANCE OF A COMMON DAY OF REST AND LEGAL HOLIDAYS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 6 of Chapter 136 is hereby further amended by
- 2 inserting after paragraph (47), the following: —
- 3 (48) The transport of amusement devices, such as, carousels,
- 4 ferris wheels, inclined railways and other similar devices,
- 5 concession stands and tents from one location to the next
- 6 between eight o'clock in the forenoon and one o'clock in the
- 7 afternoon.
