AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF ADAMS TO APPROPRIATE MONEY FOR THE PAYMENT OF, AND TO PAY, CERTAIN UNPAID BILLS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The town of Adams is hereby authorized to
2 appropriate money for the payment of, and after such
3 appropriation the treasurer of said town is hereby authorized to
4 pay, the following unpaid bills to D. Krutiak for work done at
5 Bowe Field in the amount of \$280.00, to R. Randall for work
6 done at Bowe Field in the amount of \$135.10 and to Wolverine
7 Sports for drag purchase in the amount of \$53.78, said bills being
8 legally unenforceable by reason of them not having been
9 contracted for pursuant to provisions of the by-laws of said town.

1 SECTION 2. No bill shall be approved by the accountant of
2 said town for payment or paid by the treasurer thereof under
3 authority of this act unless and until a certificate has been signed
4 and filed with said town accountant, stating under the penalties of
5 perjury that the materials or equipment for which said bill has
6 been submitted were ordered by an official or an employee of said
7 town and that such materials and equipment were delivered to
8 and actually received by said town.

1 SECTION 3. Any person who knowingly files a certificate
2 required by section two which is false and who thereby receives

3 payment for materials and equipment which were not received by
 4 said town shall be punished by imprisonment for not more than
 5 one year or by a fine of not more than three hundred dollars, or
 6 both.

1 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
