In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Five.

AN ACT PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR IMPROPERLY CARRYING AWAY OR CONVERTING A MILK CONTAINER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 266 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding
2 the following section:—

3 *Section 144.* Whoever, without permission of the owner, carries
4 away or converts to his own use a plastic or wire milk case or a
5 plastic or wire container for milk products which has been
6 indelibly stamped with the name of a milk dealer or association of
7 milk dealers shall be punished by a fine of not less than ten and
8 not more than one hundred dollars.
