

HOUSE No. 5541

By Mr. Robinson of Melrose, petition of William G. Robinson (with the approval of the mayor and board of aldermen) that the licensing authority of the city of Melrose be authorized to issue an all alcoholic beverages license to Melrose Post 90 American Legion. Government Regulations.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE TO MELROSE POST 90 AMERICAN LEGION OF A LICENSE TO SELL ALL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES TO BE DRUNK ON ITS PREMISES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section
2 sixteen C of chapter one hundred and thirty-eight of the General
3 Laws, but subject, however, to all other provisions of said
4 chapter, the licensing authority of the city of Melrose is hereby
5 authorized to grant to Melrose Post 90 American Legion a license
6 to sell all alcoholic beverages to be drunk at its post headquarters,
7 at 34 Crystal street in said city, to members of said post and to
8 guests introduced by such members, and to no others.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
