AN ACT PROVIDING THAT IN THE CITY OF PEABODY ITS DIRECTOR OF FINANCE SHALL BE THE MEMBER EX OFFICIO OF ITS RETIREMENT BOARD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:
