AN ACT PROVIDING FOR INCREASED APPOINTED REPRESENTATION ON THE BOARD OF THE MASSACHUSETTS HOME MORTGAGE FINANCE AGENCY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 3 of Chapter 846 of the acts of 1974 is hereby amended  
2 by striking the word "four" and inserting in place thereof the  
3 word "six" and inserting after the words "low income organiza-  
4 tion" the words "and two of whom shall be members of minority  
5 groups representative of residents of those areas in which the  
6 MHMFA is likely to make mortgage loans available".
