RESOLVE INCREASING THE SCOPE OF THE SPECIAL COMMISSION ESTABLISHED TO DETERMINE THE FEASIBILITY OF INCLUDING A PROVISION FOR BICYCLE PATHS IN THE DESIGN OF FEDERALLY AIDED AND STATE AIDED ROADS.

3 and most recently revived and continued by Chapter one of the
