1 *Resolved*, That for the purpose of discharging a moral
2 obligation of the Commonwealth there be allowed and paid out
3 of the state treasury, subject to appropriation, to Couture
4 Brothers, Inc., the amount of two thousand two hundred and
5 forty two dollars and forty cents for work performed at the
6 Greenfield Community College notwithstanding the failure of
7 said college to comply with the provisions of section 8A of
8 chapter 29 of the general laws.
