AN ACT RELATIVE TO APPLICATIONS FOR CERTAIN EXAMINATIONS
UNDER THE CIVIL SERVICE LAW.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:*

1 Section 8A of chapter 31 of the General Laws, as most recently
2 amended by chapter 835 of the acts of 1974, is hereby further
3 amended by striking out the second and third sentences contained
4 therein and inserting in place thereof the following:

5 The provisions of section eight relative to the sending, posting
6 and contents of notices shall apply to notices prepared under this
7 section. Applications for any such examination shall be received
8 at any time after the posting of the notice, and applicants shall be
9 given notice in writing or by oral instruction of the date of such
10 examination; provided, however, that no application shall be
11 accepted within three weeks prior to the date of such examina-
12 tion.
