RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES RELATIVE TO THE FEASIBILITY OF ESTABLISHING A STATE PARK IN HONOR OF HORACE MANN IN THE TOWN OF FRANKLIN.

1 *Resolved*, The department of natural resources is hereby
2 authorized and directed to make an investigation and study
3 relative to the feasibility of establishing a state park in honor of
4 Horace Mann within the town of Franklin. Such study shall
5 include the feasibility of establishing such park on land now
6 owned by the commonwealth but shall not be limited to
7 consideration of such land as a site for said park. Said
8 department shall report to the general court the results of its
9 investigation and study, and its recommendations, if any,
10 together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry its
11 recommendations into effect, by filing the same with the clerk of
12 the house of representatives on or before the last Wednesday of
13 December, nineteen hundred and seventy-five.
