In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Five.

AN ACT IN ADDITION TO THE GENERAL APPROPRIATION ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS TO SUPPLEMENT CERTAIN ITEMS CONTAINED THEREIN, AND FOR CERTAIN NEW ACTIVITIES AND PROJECTS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. To provide for supplementing certain items in  
2 the general appropriation act and for certain new activities and  
3 projects, the sum set forth in section two for the purpose and  
4 subject to the conditions specified therein is hereby appropriated  
5 from the General Fund unless specifically designated otherwise in  
6 the item, subject to the provisions of law regulating the  
7 disbursement of public funds and the conditions pertaining to  
8 appropriations in chapter four hundred and thirty-one, six  
9 hundred and ninety-eight, and eight hundred and fifty-five of the  
10 acts of nineteen hundred and seventy-four and chapters fifty-four  
11 and one hundred and twelve of the acts of nineteen hundred and  
12 seventy-five, for the fiscal year ending June the thirtieth, nineteen  
13 hundred and seventy-five, or for such period as may be specified,  
14 the sum so appropriated to be in addition to any amounts at  
15 present available for the purposes.
