AN ACT INCREASING THE COMPENSATION OF CERTAIN MEMBERS OF THE
GENERAL COURT.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:*

1 Section 9 of chapter 3 of the General Laws, as most recently
2 amended by chapter 679 of the acts of 1972, is hereby further
3 amended by inserting after the fifth sentence contained therein
4 the following: — The senate vice-chairman and the house vice-
5 chairman of each of the joint standing committees not herein
6 before provided for, and the ranking senior member of the
7 minority party of each of the standing committees, as determined
8 by years of membership on said committees shall receive one and
9 one-quarter times the compensation received by a member.
