AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE CONTINUED LIMITED REGISTRATION OF CERTAIN PHYSICIANS EMPLOYED AT NORTHAMPTON STATE HOSPITAL.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any other law or regulation,
2 the limited registration for the practice of medicine issued to the
3 five physicians presently employed at Northampton State
4 Hospital who are graduates of foreign medical schools shall be
5 extended so long as any one of such physicians is an employee of
6 the commonwealth and works in a state hospital, state school or
7 other mental health or retardation facility and otherwise complies
8 with the requirements for limited registration as set forth in
9 section nine of chapter one hundred and twelve of the General
10 Laws.
