

By Mr. Buxbaum of Sharon, petition of Laurence R. Buxbaum (by vote of the town) relative to the granting of licenses for the sale of alcoholic beverages by certain restaurants in the town of Sharon. Government Regulations. [Local Approval Received.]

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE GRANTING OF LICENSES FOR THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES BY CERTAIN RESTAURANTS IN THE TOWN OF SHARON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any limitations imposed by
2 section eleven or section eleven A of chapter one hundred and
3 thirty-eight of the General Laws, as to the time and manner of
4 voting upon the questions therein set forth, the selectmen of the
5 town of Sharon shall cause to be placed on the official ballot used
6 in the town of Sharon by the registered voters of the town of
7 Sharon at the annual town meeting to be held in the year nineteen
8 hundred and seventy-six the following question, to wit:

9 E. Shall licenses be granted to this town for the sale therein of
10 alcoholic beverages by restaurants and function rooms
11 having a seating capacity of not less than one hundred
12 persons?

13 If a majority of the votes cast in said town in answer to said
14 question is in the affirmative, said town shall be taken to have
15 authorized, until the end of calendar year nineteen hundred and
16 seventy-six, the sale in said town of all alcoholic beverages to be
17 drunk on the premises of restaurants and function rooms having
18 a seating capacity of not less than one hundred persons. Said
19 licenses shall be subject, however, to all the other provisions of
20 said chapter one hundred and thirty-eight.

1 SECTION 2. The state secretary shall cause to be placed on
2 the official ballot used in the town of Sharon at each biennial
3 state election the following subdivision to the question which he is
4 required under the provisions of section eleven of chapter one
5 hundred and thirty-eight of the General Laws to place on the
6 official ballot in all cities and towns at such elections, to wit:

7 E. Shall licenses be granted in this town for the sale therein of
8 all alcoholic beverages by restaurants and function
9 rooms having a seating capacity of not less than one
10 hundred persons?

11 If a majority of the votes cast in said town in answer to
12 subdivision E is in the affirmative, said town shall be taken to
13 authorize, for the two calendar years next succeeding, the sale in
14 said town of all alcoholic beverages to be drunk on the premises
15 of restaurants and function rooms having a seating capacity of
16 not less than one hundred persons. Said licenses shall be subject,
17 however, to all other provisions of said chapter one hundred and
18 thirty-eight.
