AN ACT PERMITTING CERTAIN ALIENS TO OBTAIN MARINE FISHERIES LICENSES

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The third paragraph of section 38 of chapter 130 of the General
2 Laws is hereby amended by striking out the first sentence, as most
3 recently amended by chapter 709 of the acts of 1973, and inserting
4 in place thereof the following sentence: — A non-resident of the
5 commonwealth who is a citizen of the United States or who is an
6 alien who possesses an alien registration receipt card issued to
7 him by the United States Department of Justice, Immigration
8 and Naturalization Service, temporarily residing or intending
9 temporarily to reside in any coastal city or town, and who owns
10 more than five thousand dollars in real estate within the
11 commonwealth as determined by tax records may, in any year,
12 upon payment of the fee required by this section obtain a license
13 to take lobsters or edible crabs during June, July, August and
14 September of such year, for consumption only by the licensee and
15 his family who are so residing.
