RESOLVE INCREASING THE SCOPE OF THE SPECIAL COMMISSION ESTABLISHED TO MAKE AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY RELATIVE TO THE FEASIBILITY OF RECODIFYING THE LAW PERTAINING TO THE CONTROL OF DOGS AND CATS AND OTHER MATTERS RELATIVE THERETO.

1     *Resolved*, That the special commission established by chapter  
2 one hundred and forty-one of the resolves of nineteen hundred  
3 and seventy-three and most recently revived and continued by  
4 chapter one of the resolves of nineteen hundred and seventy-five,  
5 shall in the course of its investigation and study consider the  
6 subject matter of current house document numbered 5736,  
7 providing for an investigation and study by the department of  
8 food and agriculture relative to the sale of puppies by pet shops.
