**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

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*Ordered,* That the committee on insurance be authorized to sit during the recess of the general court for the purpose of making an investigation and study of the subject matter of current house document numbered 784, relative to the issuance of life insurance policies for certain mentally retarded persons.

Said committee shall be provided with quarters in the state house or elsewhere, may hold hearings, and may expend for clerical and other services and for expenses such sums as may be appropriated therefor. Said committee shall report to the general court the results of its investigation and study, and its recommendations, if any, together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry such recommendations into effect, by filing the same with the clerk of the house of representatives on or before the last Wednesday of January, nineteen hundred and seventy-six.
