Harris, George C. Young, William G. Robinson, David J. Lane, Ann C. Gannett, Andrew S. Natsios, Andrew H. Card, Jr., Richard A. Rogers, Robert A. Manzelli, Gilbert W. Cox, Jr., and Edward M. Dickson to encourage the creation of health maintenance organizations as alternative systems of health care in the Commonwealth; and the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 2098) of James D. Allan for legislation to establish a commission on medical injury compensation, report recommending that the accompanying order (House, No. 6223) ought to be adopted.

Ordered, That the special committee authorized (under the provisions of House order No. 5049 of 1971 and most recently revived and continued under the provisions of House order No. 5325, amended, of 1975) to make an investigation and study relative to health benefits shall, in the course of its investigation and study, consider the subject matter of current house documents numbered 579, encouraging the creation of health maintenance organizations as alternative systems of health care in the commonwealth and 2098, establishing a commission on medical injury compensation.
