

By Mr. Desrocher of Nantucket, petition of Arthur L. Desrocher (by vote of the town) for legislation to provide for the eligibility of certain additional school construction grants and other benefits for the Nantucket School District. Education. [Local Approval Received.]

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Five.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE ELIGIBILITY OF CERTAIN ADDITIONAL SCHOOL CONSTRUCTION GRANTS AND OTHER BENEFITS FOR THE NANTUCKET SCHOOL DISTRICT.

1 *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to
2 defeat its purpose, which is to make the Nantucket school district
3 immediately eligible for certain school construction grants and
4 other benefits, therefore it is hereby declared to be emergency
5 law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
6 convenience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any contrary provision of law, the Nantucket
2 school district shall be eligible for sixty-five per cent of the
3 approved cost of school construction and any other benefits
4 authorized by chapter six hundred and forty-five of the acts of
5 nineteen hundred and forty-eight, as most recently amended by
6 section fourteen of chapter seven hundred and sixty-six of the
7 acts of nineteen hundred and seventy-two.
