## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Five.

AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR NINETEEN HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-SIX FOR THE MAINTENANCE OF BARNSTABLE COUNTY, ITS DEPARTMENTS, BOARDS, COMMISSIONS AND INSTITUTIONS, OF SUNDRY OTHER SERVICES, FOR CERTAIN PERMANENT IMPROVEMENTS, FOR INTEREST AND DEBT REQUIREMENTS, AND TO MEET CERTAIN REQUIREMENTS OF LAW AND GRANTING A COUNTY TAX FOR SAID COUNTY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. To provide for the maintenance of Barnstable  
2 county, its departments, boards, commissions and institutions,  
3 for sundry other services, for certain permanent improvements,  
4 for interest and debt requirements, and to meet certain  
5 requirements of law, the following sums are hereby appropriated,  
6 subject to the provisions of law regulating the disbursement of  
7 county funds and the approval thereof, for the fiscal year nineteen  
8 hundred and seventy-six.
