The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Five.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF THE DIVISION OF FISHERIES AND GAME TO GRANT TO THE TOWN OF SPENCER AN EASEMENT FOR PURPOSES OF WATER STANDPIPE AND WATER LINE INSTALLATIONS.

1 *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to
2 defeat its purpose, which is to authorize forthwith the director of
3 the division of fisheries and game to grant to the town of Spencer
4 an easement for purposes of water standpipe and water line
5 installations, therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency
6 law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
7 convenience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The director of the division of fisheries and game, with the
2 approval of the fish and game board of said division, is hereby
3 authorized to grant to the town of Spencer an easement for the
4 purpose of installing a water standpipe and a water line on the
5 following parcel of land situated in said town, County of
6 Worcester, near the Spencer-Leicester Town Line, bounded and
7 described as follows:

8 Beginning at a town line monument at the corner of Leicester,
9 Paxton and Spencer. The monument being a common corner
10 monument for the Northwesterly corner of Leicester, the
11 Southwesterly corner of Paxton and the Easterly side of Spencer.

- 12 Thence S $9^{\circ}-42'-00''$ E 1438.77 feet along the Spencer
13 Leicester Town Line to a point in the town line,
14 Thence S $80^{\circ}-18'-00''$ W 96.46 feet to the point of beginning of
15 parcel herein described.
16 Thence S $9^{\circ}-42'-00''$ E 200.00 feet to a corner,
17 Thence S $80^{\circ}-18'-00''$ W 154.73 feet to a corner,
18 Thence S $26^{\circ}-33'-07''$ W 998.78 feet to a corner,
19 Thence S $28^{\circ}-45'-30''$ E 902.79 feet to a corner, at the westerly
20 side of Donnelly Cross Road,
21 Thence S $49^{\circ}-25'-58''$ W 30.65 feet along the westerly side of
22 Donnelly Cross Road to a corner,
23 Thence N $28^{\circ}-45'-30''$ W 909.89 feet to a corner,
24 Thence N $79^{\circ}-05'-30''$ W 118.30 feet to a corner, at the easterly
25 side of land now or formerly of Frank A. Rivers,
26 Thence N $25^{\circ}-31'-46''$ W 37.29 feet along the easterly side of
27 land now or formerly of Frank A. Rivers at a corner,
28 Thence S $79^{\circ}-05'-30''$ E 136.09 feet to a corner,
29 Thence N $26^{\circ}-33'-07''$ E 973.25 feet to a corner,
30 Thence S $80^{\circ}-18'-00''$ W 8.07 feet to a corner,
31 Thence N $9^{\circ}-42'-00''$ W 200.00 feet to a corner,
32 Thence N $80^{\circ}-18'-00''$ E 200.00 feet to the point of beginning.
33 Containing 2.03 Acres.
34 Said premises are shown on an unrecorded plan entitled
35 "Commonwealth of Massachusetts, Division of Fisheries and
36 Game, Plan of Land In the Town of Spencer for Proposed
37 Potable Water Storage and Distribution Facilities For the Town
