AN ACT EXTENDING UNEMPLOYMENT COMPENSATION BENEFITS TO  
CERTAIN FEDERAL EMPLOYEES.

1     *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to  
2 defeat its purpose, which is to prevent the termination of financial  
3 assistance to certain former federal employees in July of the  
4 current year, therefore, it is hereby declared to be an emergency  
5 law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public  
6 convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as  
follows:*

1     Section 3 of chapter 558 of the acts of 1973 is hereby amended  
2 by striking out, in line 3, the words "sixth, nineteen hundred and  
3, seventy five" and inserting in place thereof the words: — fourth,  
4 nineteen hundred and seventy-six."
