AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TAUNTON POLICE MUTUAL BENEFIT ASSOCIATION TO PAY CERTAIN SUMS OF MONEY TO ITS MEMBERS UPON THEIR RETIREMENT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The Taunton Police Mutual Benefit Association, a corporation
- 2 duly established under the laws of the commonwealth, is hereby
- 3 authorized upon the retirement of any member in good standing,
- 4 to pay at the option of such member, a sum not exceeding one-
- 5 half of the death benefit payable on the death of such member.
- 6 Any amount so paid, shall reduce the death benefit otherwise
- 7 payable upon the death of such member.
