AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF MIDDLEBOROUGH TO GRANT A LIQUOR LICENSE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding the provisions of section sixteen C of chapter
- 2 one hundred and thirty-eight of the General Laws, the selectmen
- 3 of the town of Middleborough are hereby authorized to grant a
- 4 liquor license for premises known as Rock Village Store located
- 5 at Miller Street in the town of Middleborough.
