AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF GRAFTON TO USE PARK LAND FOR STREET PURPOSES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The town of Grafton is hereby authorized to use a strip of land  
2 of Whitney Park for street purposes and to lay out said strip  
3 which consists of six thousand nine hundred sixty-eight and five-  
4 tenths (6968.5) square feet as shown on a plan entitled "Layout  
5 and Decree of Mill Street located in Grafton, Mass., dated  
6 January 2, 1975, Engineering Department, Grafton,  
7 Massachusetts, Number 1-75" which is on file in the town clerk's  
8 and selectmen's offices in said town and which is described as  
9 follows:—

10 Beginning at an old stone bound at the northeast corner of said  
11 land at Martial Realty Trust property now or formerly;

12 Thence North 75° 26' 00" West one hundred twenty-six and  
13 95/100 (126.95) feet to a point;

14 Thence North 73° 53' 00" West four hundred one and 67/100  
15 (401.67) feet to a bound at land now or formerly of Washington  
16 Abrasive Mills Company;

17 Thence North 14° 14' 00" East by land of said Mill street fifteen  
18 and 00/100 (15) feet to a concrete bound as shown on said plan;

19 Thence South 73° 53' 00" East by land of Town of Grafton four  
20 hundred one and 87/100 (401.87) feet to a concrete bound;

21 Thence South 68° 40' 26" East still by land of the Town one  
22 hundred twenty-seven and 22/100 (127.22) feet to the point of  
23 beginning.
