AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE APPOINTMENT OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS
OF THE MASSACHUSETTS BAY TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:*

1 The first paragraph of section 6 of Chapter 161A of the General
2 Laws, as inserted by section 10 of Chapter 1140 of the Acts of
3 1973, is hereby amended by striking out the second and third
4 sentences as appearing therein and inserting in place thereof the
5 following sentence: — The approvals by the fourteen cities and
6 towns, the Advisory Board and the sixty-four cities and towns as
7 required by this section shall be determined by a majority vote of
8 their mayors or city managers or chairman of selectmen and the
9 provisions of section seven of this chapter shall not apply.
