AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF BOSTON TO PLACE AN ADVISORY QUESTION ON THE BALLOT AT THE CITY ELECTION IN NOVEMBER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 That the Board of Election Commissioners of the city of
2 Boston shall place the following question on the ballot for that
3 city's election to be held on November 4, 1975:

4 Do you oppose one hundred percent valuation of taxable
5 property?
