

By Mr. Wilber of Barnstable, petition of Bernard Wilber (by vote of the town) that the local licensing authority of the town of Barnstable be authorized to issue an all alcoholic beverages license to the Hyannisport Club, Inc. Government Regulations. [Local Approval Received.]

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE LOCAL LICENSING AUTHORITY OF THE TOWN OF BARNSTABLE TO ISSUE ALL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES LICENSE TO THE HYANNISPORT CLUB, INC.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any limitation on the number of licenses to be
2 issued under the provisions of section seventeen of chapter one
3 hundred and thirty-eight of the General Laws, but subject,
4 however, to all other provisions of said chapter, the licensing
5 authority of the town of Barnstable is hereby authorized to issue
6 to the Hyannisport Club, Inc. an annual club license to sell all
7 alcoholic beverages, to be drunk on their premises, to their
8 members and to guests introduced by such members and to no
9 others.

10 Said license shall not be transferable to any other licensee and
11 shall not be included in the number of licenses issued under
12 authority of said section seventeen; provided, however, that if
13 there is an addition to the quota of such licenses in said town
14 under said section seventeen because of an increase in population
15 in said town, then said licenses shall not be included in such new
16 quota.
