HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, November 18, 1975.

The committee on Ways and Means, to whom was recommitted the Bill to extend the period of abandonment for travelers checks and to allow the sellers or issuers of travelers checks to make payments to the holders thereof after the period of abandonment (House, No. 709); and to whom were referred the Bill increasing the portion of earnings disregarded by certain unemployment compensation recipients (printed as House, No. 154, changed and amended); the Bill further defining administrative powers of the Department of Public Welfare (House, No. 294); the Bill relative to the transportation of pupils attending certain private schools (House, No. 1092); the Bill relative to the licensing of real estate brokers and salesmen (House, No. 2894); the Bill authorizing the licensing of corporations as insurance advisors (House, No. 3672); the Bill to require a public hearing pursuant to the Administrative Procedures Act on proposed classifications of risks and premiums for purposes of workmen's compensation insurance (House, No. 3863); the Bill authorizing the creation of subregions within the Massachusetts Bay Transportation Authority region (House, No. 4343); the Bill modifying the suspension period which may be invoked by the Department of Public Utilities relative to rate, price or charge changes (House, No. 6146); the Bill allowing for flexibility in fixing the interest rate to be paid on delinquent property taxes and tax title accounts (House, No. 6290); the Bill exempting from taxation certain resource recovery facilities (House, No. 6547); the Bill to insure minimum state funding to municipalities (House, No. 6598, changed); the Bill authorizing the Department of Fisheries, Wildlife and Recreational Vehicles to lease certain property located in the town of Sutton to said town (House, No. 6608, changed); the Bill relative to the appointment of the Board of Directors of the Massachusetts Bay Transportation Authority (House, No. 6613); the Bill to provide a procedure for the acceptance by the Commonwealth of retrocessions of legislative jurisdiction over certain property previously ceded to the federal government (printed in House, No. 6663); and the Bill authorizing the Massachusetts Aeronautics Commission to collect reimbursement charges for

providing air transportation (House, No. 6764), report recommending that the accompanying order (House, No. 6796) ought to be adopted.
