AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF PLYMOUTH TO MAKE ALTERATIONS AND REPAIRS ON THE UNION STREET BRIDGE OVER THE NORTH RIVER BETWEEN THE TOWNS OF MARSHFIELD AND NORWELL.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The county commissioners of the county of
2 Plymouth are hereby authorized to make certain alterations
3 and repairs not exceeding sixty thousand dollars on the
4 Union Street bridge over the North river between the towns
5 of Marshfield and Norwell.

1 SECTION 2. The cost of repairs shall be borne in like
2 manner as set forth in chapter seven hundred and ninety-
3 seven of the acts of nineteen hundred and sixty. Of the total
4 cost of repairs the department of public works shall bear
5 sixty-two per cent, the county of Plymouth twenty-six per
6 cent, the town of Marshfield six per cent and the town of
7 Norwell six per cent.

1 SECTION 3. The treasurer of the county of Plymouth is
2 hereby authorized to borrow on the credit of the county for
3 these repairs not exceeding sixty thousand dollars.

1 SECTION 4. Each town of Marshfield and Norwell acting
2 through their respective boards of selectmen may expend
3 from amounts approved at town meetings a sum not to
4 exceed thirty-six hundred dollars for the purpose of effecting
5 said repairs to the bridge. The county commissioners shall, as
6 soon as may be after completion of work, notify the select-
7 men of each town of the amount of cost apportioned thereto
8 and each town shall pay said amount into the treasury of the
9 county within sixty days thereafter.

1 SECTION 5. Sums necessary to carry out the provisions of
2 this act shall be appropriated from the Highway Fund as the
3 commonwealth's share of the cost of said repairs to the
4 bridge.

1 SECTION 6. Any balance of monies remaining, from what-
2 ever source, upon the satisfactory completion of the said
3 alterations and repairs shall revert as follows: sixty-two per
4 cent to the Highway Fund referred to in section five, twenty-
5 six per cent to the county of Plymouth, six per cent to the
6 town of Marshfield and six per cent to the town of Norwell.

1 SECTION 7. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
