*To the Honorable Senate and House of Representatives:*

I am returning, herewith, without my approval, House Bill No. 4336 entitled "An Act prohibiting the suspension or revocation of a motor vehicle license solely because of the issuance of one or two warnings under the no-fix traffic law, so-called."

When I returned the bill for amendment, I had requested that the bill be clarified so there would be no question as to whether or not the Registrar had the right to suspend for offenses of a serious nature.

I am still very much in doubt as to whether the Registrar's right in performing his duties has been curtailed to the extent that the safety of the public might be endangered.

Under the circumstances I have no alternative but to return this bill without my approval.
