AN ACT TO PROVIDE COMPENSATION TO MEDICAL CONSULTANTS IN STATE SERVICE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to
2 the contrary, any physician, dentist or other person regis-
3 tered under General Law 112 shall be entitled to reimburse-
4 ment under Public Law 89-97, Mass. Medical Service or other
5 third party payor for services rendered to a patient in any
6 institution operated by the Commonwealth or any county or
7 municipality within the Commonwealth.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect on July first, nineteen
2 hundred and sixty-six.
