AN ACT

To incorporate the Central Trust Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Edgar R. Champlin, John H.
2 Corcoran, Asa P. Morse, Charles Bullock, David
3 A. Ritchie, Charles P. Keith, Levi Hawkes, Will
4 F. Roaf and Joseph A. Wolcott, their associates
5 and successors, are hereby made a corporation
6 under the name of the Central Trust Company.

1 SECTION 2. Said corporation shall have au-
2 thority to establish and maintain a safe deposit
3 and trust company in that part of the city of
4 Cambridge, formerly known as Cambridgeport,
5 with all the privileges and powers, and subject
6 to all the duties, liabilities and restrictions set
7 forth in all general laws now or hereafter in force
8 relating to such corporations.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
