

SENATE No. 192.

To accompany the petition of Dennis F. O'Connell for legislation to provide for licensing slot machines. Judiciary.

Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Four.

AN ACT

Relative to Slot Machines.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. No slot machine shall be per-
2 mitted to be operated or maintained upon any
3 premises to which the public are invited unless
4 the owner or operator of said machine shall have
5 first obtained from the licensing board of any
6 city or town a license to operate or maintain said
7 machine upon said premises.

1 SECTION 2. No license shall be issued by the
2 licensing board of any city or town unless there
3 accompanies the petition for license a fee of five

4 dollars for each license desired, and in case said
5 license is granted the licensee shall pay annually
6 to said licensing board a fee of five dollars for
7 every machine operated or maintained by said
8 licensee.

1 SECTION 3. The date for annual payment of
2 fees shall be left to discretion of the licensing
3 board.
