To accompany the petition of Louis E. Dolliff for legislation relative to the testing of gas meters. Public Lighting.

Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Four.

AN ACT

Relative to the testing of Gas Meters.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 A gas company providing a meter for measur-
2 ing gas supplied to a consumer shall upon written
3 request of such consumer obtain a test of such
4 meter by the gas inspector or by one of his assist-
5 ants or a deputy as provided in section eleven of
6 chapter fifty-eight of the Revised Laws. A gas
7 company failing when so requested by a consumer
8 to obtain a test of such meter by the gas inspector
9 shall be punished by a fine of five dollars for
10 every such failure to comply with such request.
