AN ACT

To extend the Jurisdiction of the Police Court of
Lowell.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The towns of Tewksbury, Bil-
2 lERICA, Dracut, Chelmsford, Dunstable and Tyngs-
3 borough in the county of Middlesex are hereby
4 annexed to and made a part of the judicial district
5 and subject to the jurisdiction of the police court
6 of Lowell; but this act shall not affect any suit or
7 other proceeding now pending before any justice
8 or court having jurisdiction of the same.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
