RESOLVE

To Confirm the Acts of Lewis W. Howes as a Notary
Public.

1 *Resolved*, That all the acts done by Lewis W. Howes
2 of Boston, in said Commonwealth, as a notary public,
3 between the seventh day of April, in the year eighteen
4 hundred and ninety-three, and the sixth day of March,
5 eighteen hundred and ninety-five, are hereby confirmed
6 and made valid to the same extent as though he had been,
7 during that time, qualified to discharge the duties of said
8 office.
