AN ACT

To establish the Salaries of the Justice and Clerk of the Police Court of Marlborough.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The salary of the justice of the
2 police court of Marlborough shall be fifteen hun-
3 dred dollars a year and that of the clerk of said
4 court eight hundred dollars a year, to be so
5 allowed from the first day of January in the year
6 eighteen hundred and ninety-two.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
