AN ACT

Making Appropriations for Salaries and Expenses at the Lyman School for Boys at Westborough.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The sums hereinafter mentioned
2 are appropriated, to be paid out of the treasury of
3 the Commonwealth, from the ordinary revenue,
4 for the payment of salaries and expenses at the
5 Lyman school for boys at Westborough, for the
6 year ending on the thirty-first day of December
7 in the year eighteen hundred and ninety-two,
8 to wit:—

9 For the payment of salaries, wages and labor
10 at the Lyman school for boys at Westborough, a
11 sum not exceeding nineteen thousand and eighty-
12 five dollars, and for other current expenses at said

13 institution, a sum not exceeding twenty-seven
14 thousand five hundred dollars. [Pub. Stat.,

(Appropriation 1891: salaries, \$17,785; expenses, \$26,915.)

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
