## Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

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In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Ninety-two.

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### AN ACT

To change the Name of the East Gloucester Baptist Society and to limit the Purpose for which said Corporation was formed.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. That the name of the East  
2 Gloucester Baptist Society be changed to that of  
3 the Parish of the Chapel Street Baptist Church of  
4 Gloucester.

5 SECT. 2. That the purposes for which said  
6 corporation was formed be changed to the follow-  
7 ing, viz.: the maintainance of the religious  
8 worship of the Chapel Street Baptist Church of said  
9 Gloucester, and to hold property and receive  
10 donations in trust for the benefit of said church.
