AN ACT

To authorize the East Side Street Railway Company to lease its Railway, Franchises and other Property to the Brockton Street Railway Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The East Side Street Railway
2 Company is hereby authorized to lease its railway,
3 franchises and other property to the Brockton
4 Street Railway Company, upon such terms as the
5 directors and stockholders of the respective cor-
6 porations may agree or have agreed upon. Such
7 lease shall not cover a period of more than ninety-
8 nine years.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
