AN ACT

Providing for a Fifth Assistant Clerk of the Superior Court, Civil Session, for the County of Suffolk.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The clerk of the superior court
2 for the county of Suffolk may, subject to the
3 approval of a majority of the justices of said
4 court, appoint a fifth assistant clerk of said
5 court for said county for civil business, who shall
6 be subject to the provisions of law applicable
7 to assistant clerks of courts in said county and
8 who shall receive in full for all services per-
9 formed by him an annual salary of twenty-five
10 hundred dollars, to be paid by said county.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its pas-
2 sage.
