AN ACT

Relative to the Revocation of a Will on the Marriage
of the Testator.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 The marriage of any person shall act as a revo-
2 cation of any will made by such person previous
3 to such marriage unless it shall appear from the
4 will itself that the will was made in contempla-
5 tion of such marriage, or unless and except so
6 far as the will is made in exercise of a power
7 of appointment and the estate thereby appointed
8 would not in default of appointment pass to the
9 persons that would have been entitled to the same
10 if it had been the testator's own estate and he or
11 she had died without disposing of it by will.
