RESOLVE

In favor of Augustus Barnes.

1 *Resolved*, That Augustus Barnes of Boston, who served
2 as paymaster's clerk and captain's clerk in the United
3 States navy during the war of the rebellion, and who,
4 at date of appointment was a citizen and resident of
5 Massachusetts, shall, from and after the passage of this
6 resolve, be eligible to receive state or military aid under
7 the provisions, rules and limitations of chapters three
8 hundred and one, and two hundred and seventy-nine of
9 the acts of the year eighteen hundred and eighty-nine, in
10 the same manner and to the same extent he would have
11 been had he served to the credit of this Commonwealth.
